Various people joined me: ALC members, neighbors, a SD Synod staff member, middle schoolers from a church volunteer crew, and other visitors. It was a steady flow of smiles, friendly waves, and conversation.

ALC is planted in a busy neighborhood, as you most likely know. How are we visible? How can we re-engage with and support our neighbors? What shall we do?

At the end of the Parable of the Good Samaritan, Jesus asks: "Which one of these...was a neighbor...?" The hearer responded: "The one who showed mercy." And, Jesus said: "Go and do likewise."

a word from The Church Council

Hello from Anna Amundson, the new council president. I accepted this position after Brian Lambertz resigned from the council in April. We are sorry to see him go and we would like to thank him for his service to our congregation.

The church council continues to work during this time of transition. This month, along with other members, we've continued the cleaning and organizing at the church, served Food To You, reached out to homebound members with May baskets and elected a Call Committee.

Last week, four council members and Pastor Jon met with Bishop Constanze Hagmaier, Pastor Renee Splichal Larson and Pastor Jonathan Steiner from the South Dakota Synod of the ELCA. The pandemic has changed our congregation significantly, and synod staff offered support and advice for moving forward. Pastor Jonathan has offered to continue working with us regarding new ways to reach out to our neighbors, and we will let you know how you can take part in these conversations as they continue.

Thank you to everyone who continues to offer their time, money and prayers to sustain our congregation.





On Thursday mornings in June and July, Anna Amundson (ALC President) and Interim Pastor Jon are taking an online continuing education course through Wartburg Seminary (ELCA seminary) and Dialog Works called *Practical Tools for the Journey*. Each week Anna and Pastor Jon join 11 other pastors and lay leaders from four different states to discuss the needs of small congregations going through periods of transition. Rev. Peter Soli, one of the instructors of the course, is Rev. Karen Soli's brother and is familiar

with Augustana Lutheran. Anna says of the course: "I am hoping to gather information and ideas for our congregation as we decide how to move forward with the work of the call committee and our church's mission to serve our neighbors."
