Last month we held the annual Block Party/Fiesta hosted by Augustana Lutheran Church and Pueblo de Dios. (Fun pictures included in newsletter). What a wonderful tradition and partnership between these two congregations! Thank you to the many people who made it

happen, including our siblings in Christ from Pueblo de Dios.

Prior to the party, the two congregations worshiped together. Bi-lingual worship services are beautiful. We come together to hear the message of the Gospel, share the holy meal, and be wrapped in song. Even though it's not easy to fully understand every word spoken, we know the Word of God is working and alive, a sign of the Holy Spirit among us.

As part of the worship service ALC member Jackie D. and I co-led a "Thanksgiving for Baptism." We've done versions of this during previous month worship services. It is a 6 - Wedding; Block Party Fiesta reminder of the ways God delivered God's people from and through the waters, and a reminder of Jesus's own baptism. In the "Thanksgiving for Baptism" we did an aspersion, an ancient practice of sprinkling of water on the congregation. We used tree branches (freshly cut from my own yard) to sprinkle water on members from Augustana Lutheran Church, members from Pueblo de Dios, and guests. Then we sprinkled water on the church building. Then water was sprinkled in the direction of our neighborhood and world. Let's remember this in worship, activities, and daily life.

It is a sign of God's blessing! And, a reminder of our calling as agents of blessing in the world. The annual block party/fiesta is a sign of God's work through us, joining us together, and blessing our neighbors and members. The water sprinkled is a sign of God's blessing that is for all people.

Each week as we gather for worship we remember God's grace. And, it also prepares us for service and blessing in the world. Let's remember this in worship, activities, and daily life.




#### **Book Discussion meets every**



Per our request, the church loan with the Mission Investment Fund has been re-amortized to lower the monthly payments. Beginning in


October, mortgage payments will be reduced to \$904 per month.

#### From the Bishop's Desk

Partners in ministry across South Dakota,

Grace and peace to you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit! - I would like to use this opportunity to invite you to our "Fall Leadership Night". Please, join us on Zoom for an evening with your ministry partners. We had a zoom gathering for leaders

in the Spring, over 100 congregation leaders gathered to spend an hour discerning and learning "I have been elected to council, now what?" This fall we hope to gather as many lay and rostered leaders to think about stewarding the church into the future. Representatives from Portico, Lutheran Planned Generosity will join your synod staff in a 1 1/2 hour interactive time with you.
