The word "apostle" that we read in the Bible means "one who is sent." Jesus sent his 12 disciples out "to preach and to have authority to cast out demons" (Mark 3:14-15). He sent seventy-two others in pairs "to every town and place where he himself intended to go," as a sort of advance team (Luke 10:1).

Over the past few weeks, I have met some people Augustana Lutheran

Church has "sent" to other locations. At least one went to Iowa, another to Minnesota, still others to neighborhoods and churches across town. It's fun seeing people's eyes light up when they say, "I used to go there!"

Congregations can sometimes grieve the people who have left, either for other congregations or communities, or to nowhere in particular. All of those have been formed in some way by the congregations they have left—I would hope in good ways. I would hope, for example, they have been formed by the good news they have heard preached, taught, delivered via the sacraments, and/or by God's people in their former congregations.

I wonder what would happen if we in the church did a better job of sending those who leave, whether high-school graduates, people transferring to other congregations, or merely moving to different living situations—including the elderly. There are rituals for that, and some congregations make better use of those than others. I confess I have not done too well in that regard in the past.

Soon some of our youngest members (along with some adults in our congregation) will be heading to school for another year. At the end of this month we will hold a "blessing of the backpacks" at worship. We may say we are blessing the backpacks, but we are actually blessing those who will carry them, to keep them safe and guide them in their learning. I would also ask that God would bless and *send them* as carriers of God's love as they interact with others in their schools, whether other students, educators, or staff.

Wherever you go this month, may God send you with his loving Spirit!

Sunday August 21, we will have the Blessing of the Backpacks.


Students bring your backpacks to have them blessed during the church service. We will also bless teachers, school employees & bus employees.
