Augustana is on the way to paying off the mortgage on the twenty-year-old addition building. Of the \$530,000 loan taken out to finance the construction, less than \$14,000 remains! As part of the 140th Anniversary celebration, the Church Council and Endowment Committee would like to gather 140 one-hundred-dollar donations by the anniversary celebration in January.

If we get there, we'll have a "mortgage burning," either literal or figurative, as part of the celebration. Carla Diede and her kids made a poster picturing 140 birthday candles. One candle will be colored in or "lit" for each \$100 gathered. You may "light" more than one. Checks may be made payable to

Augustana Lutheran Church, with "Mortgage" in the memo line. We hope to get a relatively easy way to donate online as well. Join in the fun, and let's "light up" the mortgage.




Noisy Offering-The Noisy Offering is going to Church on the Street.



The author was seventeen the first time she set foot in a classroom and after that, pursued learning for a decade, eventually earning a PhD in history.


