LENT BEGINS FEB. 14

This year Ash Wednesday falls on Feb. 14, Valentine's Day, and we are reminded of the verse from Psalm 51: "Create in me a clean heart, O Lord, and renew a right spirit within me" (Psalm 51:10). Worship on Ash Wednesday will be at 6:00 p.m. Midweek worship throughout the rest of Lent will also be Wednesdays at 6:00 p.m., using Holden Evening Prayer. Worshipers are invited to dine with the LOGOS students and leaders at 5:30 p.m. Come purify your hearts and be fed by the presence of God and the gathered community.

#### TIME TO BE STILL

"Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth" (Psalm 46:10).

An Easter-like crowd of thirty-five people turned out for worship on the Sunday of Augustana's annual meeting! Important discussions were on the agenda, and both members and nonmembers were invited to participate in those discussions. Chief among the issues were some major building repairs and the shortage of funds to make them or even to keep up with the ongoing needs of ministry. Several ideas were offered, some of which will be researched by the church council and/or the endowment committee and/or myself. In the meantime, I believe God is calling us to take a moment to "be still" and reflect on what God is doing in our midst.

In their book, *When Church Stops Working: A Future for Your Congregation beyond More Money, Programs, and Innovation,* Andrew Root and Blaire Bertrand observe that in response to declining church participation brought on by both the pandemic and changing social values, church leaders have become desperate to find more people and more money through increasingly diverse church programming. That urgency and the energy expended, the authors say, are burning out both pastors and churches. Instead of that, they ask, "What if the answer is to stop and wait on God?" The psalmist, it seems, would agree, saying, on our Creator's behalf: "Be still and know that I am God."

I have begun trying that. Each morning before I rise from bed, I listen to God's word and prayers from an Episcopal Morning Prayer podcast. Tuesday mornings, before going to work, I have started taking time to simply sit and enjoy some Christian music of various kinds. I admit to being a "doer," and even my kids can attest to how hard it can be for me to just "be still."

There is an old adage, "Don't just stand there, do something." Recently the chaplains with whom I work have started to emphasize the opposite: "Don't just do something, stand there." Just *be* with the people who are sick, grieving, and/ or in pain. Especially at those times when there are no words, just to *be* there can be a great comfort.

It can be hard to restrain the compulsion to always do. I know. But, especially where God is concerned, such restraint is needed. The Bible is replete with stories of people who try to "do something" instead of waiting on God, usually with disastrous results. Jesus himself urged his disciples to wait for the Holy Spirit before launching into ministry following his ascension into heaven (Acts 1:4). As we enter into the season of Lent this month, I encourage us all to "take a breath" amid the urgency of the moment and wait: *wait* for the Spirit to move, *listen* for the voice of God, and then be ready to *follow* the Spirit's lead.

#### COUNCIL MEMBERS NEW AND RETURNING

One new council member and two returning officers were elected during Augustana's Annual Meeting in January. Frank Alvine was elected to fill a vacant spot on the council. Jim Sanden was reelected as president and Dave Stellingwerf was re-elected Vice-President. The remaining council members are Crystal Bartling and Jennifer Soule. The current secretary and treasurer are Terry Engebretson and Linda Sande, respectively. Those positions are appointed by the church council, which will meet again on Tuesday Feb. 13. Installation for officers and church council members will take place during worship on Sunday Feb. 4.
