### CELEBRATING OUR FIRST YEAR TOGETHER

It's hard to believe that it's already been a year since I came to Augustana! In the past year I have gotten to know many of you, visited those who cannot attend worship due to health and/or mobility issues, engaged in ministry with our partner con-

gregation Pueblo de Dios, and developed relationships with many in the neighborhood around Augustana. Together we have celebrated 140 years of ministry, grown closer to paying off the twenty-year mortgage on the building addition, and welcomed new members through baptism and transfer.

There have been some challenges to be sure, chief among them being the challenge of meeting the financial needs of ministry with a small worshiping congregation. We are in critical need of your support to meet ongoing monthly expenses as we head into the summer months.

I am grateful to those of you who regularly support the work we do together, especially those who go "above and beyond." This is a critical time, however, so I would appreciate your prayers for the congregation and any increased generosity you can provide. Your leaders are working to enable online giving, but it takes time to get everything in place. In the meantime, please bring or mail your contributions to Augustana at the address found on the mailing flap.

I truly believe that God provides for those who seek to do Jesus' work in their communities. I see Augustana doing just that, and I continue to hear evidence of that in other people's comments. With your help we can continue that impact and increase it. Augustana's impact even more! I look forward to what we can accomplish in our second year together.

#### Augustana Lutheran Church Council Minutes April 4, 2023

**CALL TO ORDER** at 6:00 by President Jim. Present were Pastor John Paulson, Jim Sanden, Dave Stellingwerf, Jennifer Soule, Linda Sanden, Terry Engebretson.

**DEVOTIONS** Pastor John led devotions from 1Corinthians Chapter 11.

"Remember Jesus in our midst."

APPROVAL OF AGENDA Jennifer motioned to accept the agenda and Linda seconded. Motion passed.

MINUTES Jennifer motioned to accept the council minutes from March 13. Linda seconded, and motion passed.

FINANCIAL MATTERS/TREASURER'S REPORT Linda reported that progress is being made on the use of Quick Books. The report included current outstanding bills and bank balances. She said that the 2023 General Offering amount of \$15,447.64 and the Building on Faith amount of \$1305.04 were

transposed on our financial report for last month. She will inform the office of that correction.

We then had a discussion regarding our outstanding bills in the 30 and 60 day range. Dave motioned and Jennifer seconded that the bills which accept credit card payment be paid with our Wells Fargo card. Motion carried.

Linda reported that Diane has been providing music for Lenten services so would be entitled to wages for 4 more services. Jennifer motioned and Dave seconded to make this payment. Motion carried.

Linda will speak to our congregation on Easter Sunday regarding the need for more donations to pay our expenses.

Jennifer motioned and Terry seconded to accept the Treasurer's report. Motion carried.

Assembly, which will focus on rural ministry.

#### MINISTRY AREAS

**Pueblo de Dios** Pastor Maria will translate the agreement document so it appears in English and Spanish. We may be attending PdD service on May 28, or they may worship with ALC on that Pentecost Sunday. Pr. John will speak with Pr. Maria regarding the service.

Worship Ministry Easter lilies can be brought to the church this week.

**Stewardship Ministry** The mortgage we owe is \$4327.57.

#### **Christian Education Ministry**

**Servant Ministry** There was discussion on serving at the Banquet. Tabled for now as we lack the number of volunteers required for this ministry.

Property Management Ministry Dave supplied a speaker update. A local company advised that we replace the amplifier and fine tune the signal. They will run a demo of these updates to see how they work before we decide to hire them. Dave has some projects in store, including finding a home for 2 donated cribs, pruning some hedges, and a church wide cleanup. Central Church may provide some young people to help us with projects again this year. Dave will replace the broken window with regular window glass until enough money is raised to replace with stained glass. He researched light bulb security cameras per Jim's idea last week. They use a standard bulb screw in which could work

on some inside fixtures. PdD provides church cleaning the 2nd and 4th weeks of the month.

#### NEIGHBORS HELPING NEIGHBORS






