### A LITTLE SOMETHING EXTRA FOR LENT

It's common for many Christians to "give up" something during the Lenten season. tradition, the idea is that each year during Lent, Christians will mimic Jesus's actions wilderness, where he went forty days without eating. During Lent, therefore, Christians are invited to give up some comfort or adopt some spiritual practice that leads to self-examination, repentance from sin, and, ultimately, renewal of the soul, all in anticipation of greater dedication to serving God and others, and of the celebration of Jesus' resurrection at Easter.

Whether you decide to give something up for Lent this year or not, I invite you to consider *adding* some extra time for worship and/or Bible study with your siblings in Christ. For example:

On Feb. 22, I began leading a <u>weekly "hybrid" Bible study</u> with the theme "Walk Dusty," both in person and via Zoom. This will continue each Wednesday through Apr. 5 <u>from 12:15 to 12:45 p.m.</u> Those who want to meet in person can meet in the Gail Jereb Room at the church. For any who want to meet virtually, we will also email a link to the Zoom meeting to those who receive this newsletter in that way. Or you may request a link by emailing pastor@augstanasiouxfalls.com. Whether you at one session or all of them, we invite you join the discussion as we journey through the dusty road of Lent.

We will also be offering Lenten midweek worship in conjunction with LOGOS. For five weeks beginning Mar. 8, you are invited to gather with the LOGOS youth and staff for a <u>meal Wednesdays at 5:30 p.m. and worship at 6:00</u>, using the sung liturgy, "Holden Evening Prayer."

Good neighbors watch out for one another! The Cathedral Historic District Neighborhood Watch Group will be hosting a neighborhood potluck at Augustana Lutheran on Thursday, Mar. 23, at 5:30 p.m. The purpose: to generate funds to help Augustana replace the stained glass window that vandals broke this past fall and to purchase and help provide added security for the building and grounds. The cost is estimated at between \$1000 and 5000, depending on the security measures adopted. Augustana members who live in the neighborhood are invited to join their neighbors for this generous expression of goodwill. Anyone, however, can donate by sending a check to the church with "Stained Glass" in the memo line.

March will be Hearty Soup/ Toilet paper










### YOU CAN HELP YOUR CHURCH BY BUYING AND USING HYVEE


