A GIFT OF TIME

Sunday morning, Nov. 5, clocks in this part of the country will revert to Central Standard time, and people will, theoretically at least, "get an extra hour of sleep" during the night. Whether one takes advantage of that extra hour is obviously a matter of choice and/or circumstances.

Taking an extra hour to rest can often seem opposed to what society expects, but from the very beginning of the world, God ordained that there should be a time of rest, a true Sabbath for body and soul—indeed for all of Creation.

"On the sixth day God finished the work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all the work that he had done. So God blessed the seventh day and hallowed it, because on it God rested from all the work that he had done in creation" (Genesis 2:1-2).

I encourage you, on the upcoming First Sunday of Standard Time or on the Saturday prior, to embrace the extra hour given you by this yearly "fall back" in time. Use it as a time for rest and healing, in whatever way seems right for your situation. And may God bless your Sabbath time.
