Jesus was born to that young couple in humble beginnings. Jesus is born into every corner of the world. And, Jesus is born to us in all of the beauty and complexity of life.




# What's Happening See what's happening this month!





#### Summary:

Total income for the month of October was \$6,383.20 vs. a budget of \$13,562.50 for an unfavorable variance of \$7,179.30 or 52.9%. On a year-to-date basis, the income from Jan. through Oct. was \$100,334 vs. a budget of \$135,625 for an unfavorable variance of \$35,291 or 26%.

Unpaid past-due bills outstanding at the end of October totaled \$6,355.93.

Balance remaining on the church mortgage: \$27,903.
